Ash Wednesday is a solemn day of prayer that begins the season of Lent. On this day we confess our sin in repentance. During Lent's forty days we are invited to carry out the Lenten discipline, practices of fasting, prayer, reading God's Word, and works of love.

On this day you may receive the sign of ashes in the form of a cross as you come forward for communion. This ancient symbol of repentance reminds



us of our mortality. Returning to God's mercy and grace, marked with the cross of Christ, we make our way through Lent, longing for the baptismal waters of Easter, our spiritual rebirth.

We invite you to the observance of Holy Lent, by self-examination and repentance; with prayer, fasting, and works of love, and with reading and meditating on God's Holy Word. As we begin this walk through these 40 days together, let us begin by confessing our sins together and asking for our Father for strength to persevere through His grace in Jesus Christ.

Join us in the Sanctuary after the Holden Evening Prayer service for a class titled, "Patterns of Prayer". In this five week class we will look at different types of prayer styles and also experience them together. These include:

## Haiti Medical Mission January 6 - 14, 2012 Report

We had a very successful mission to Haiti. Our team was made up of 21 people, half medical professionals and half non-medical people. We saw over 550 patients during our 4 clinic days, Dr. Ng did several "lumps and bumps" surgeries (on a wooden table, on a concrete floor, standing in a puddle, with a chicken walking by, and by flashlight!) and others brought healing and God's love to many sick people. I asked the team to share some of their memories with all of you. Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! We are incredibly thankful for your support, prayers and love as we continue our journey at Princeton Theological Seminary. Here's another update on what we have been up to...

### Chris & Princeton

I (Chris) have now completed a year and a half of course work which means I am officially halfway done with the Master of Divinity degree. WOO! The time has flown by. I am serving at St. Paul Lutheran Church in East Windsor, NJ, as a pastoral intern and continue to focus my course interest in missional theology, administrative organization, and teaching. Currently I am discerning whether to apply to become a "dual" student adding another master's degree focusing on youth ministry to deeper develop my skills as a youth/family worker. This would add another year of studies on top of our program. Please keep that in your prayers for us!

### Puerto Rico Internship

This summer I have been accepted as 1 of 11 students to be sent by Princeton to experience an international field education internship. For 10-12 weeks I will be serving at Centros Sor Isolina Ferre, Inc., as a youth & family advocate/guide in San Juan, Puerto Rico!! This is extremely exciting for both Carly and me as we continue to discern God's leading for our vocation in service within youth/family ministry. While in Puerto Rico, I will also be assisting with research regarding the "double colonial theology" in the island along with being a traveling preacher visiting many churches. Carly and I consider this a unique opportunity that few schools could afford to their students and we are thankful to be offered an invitation to be sent. Our life and journey thus far has serious been exciting & unreal!! You never know what or where being faithful and willing to be sent will take you!

### Carly

Carly continues to practice physical therapy at Jersey Central Physical Therapy & Fitness and is thriving! She loves treating orthopedic patients children-geriatrics and has enjoyed the continuing education opportunities her clinic has generously offered her. This summer she even had the opportunity to work with rehabbing a NY Jets football player! She is doing great and we are so grateful for her job!

### The Baldwins & Support

We both are doing well but of course miss you all, along with family & friends. We have yet to have any winter snow but the temperatures are in the decline (currently about 36 degrees outside). Enjoy our attached Christmas card! And please keep us in your prayers.

Currently, our largest challenge as being a "sent people" is the upcoming internship in Puerto Rico. We will have a few costs that we will be responsible for (vaccinations, visa, passport, etc.), but the school will be generous with all other accommodations. We do not consider ourselves sent as individuals but sent from communities - GSLC is the community where we have been sent. You are all very much invited to be part of our ministry opportunities.

Also, the internship poses a challenge of being far from Carly for the summer. Carly will be coming to visit for a week but will be in NJ with her practice as I am away. We believe that as we act out in faithfulness God will in turn be faithful to us in our marriage and as individuals. 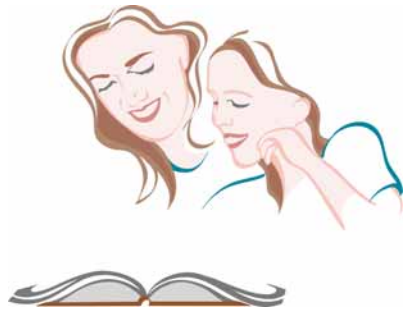
### Parenting Resources

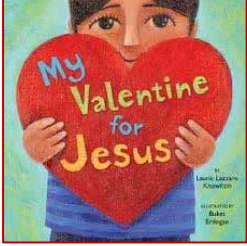
can personally learn from His example. Relevant conversation and tough questions continue to arise every single week, and we have a great time getting to know God, and each other, better. Join
